

Worship in the Chapel

Christ Church Cathedral has been a place of prayer for hundreds of years and is at the heart of our College. The Cathedral is our College Chapel and you are warmly invited to share in its worship and enjoy its world-renowned music, art, and architecture every day. You can enter at almost any hour between 7am and 7pm for prayer or to attend services or events.

Morning Prayer and the Eucharist are offered by cathedral clergy early each morning. Evensong is sung by one of our world-famous choirs most days at 6pm, and on four Mondays by the College Choir. The regular pattern of Cathedral worship can be found here: <u>www.chch.ox.ac.uk/cathedral</u>

College Communion

Sundays at 9am in the Cathedral's Lady Chapel Our weekly service is simple, friendly and informal, with a short sermon and Holy Communion. After every service we have (free) breakfast together in the McKenna Room. All are warmly welcome, regardless of denomination.

About this term's preachers:

The Revd Dr Zachary Guiliano is Interim College Chaplain; the Revd Philippa White is the Precentor at the Cathedral; the Venerable Jonathan Chaffey is the Archdeacon of Oxford; Dr Christopher Wadibia is a scholar of global Christianity, religion, and politics; the Revd Lucie Spiers is curate at St Mary Magdalen's and at St Barnabas, Jericho; and Canon Dr Will Lamb is Vicar of the University Church and an honorary canon of Christ Church.

Night Prayer and Special Services

Services of Night Prayer (Compline and Taizé) take place in the Cathedral Sanctuary by candlelight, and incorporate traditional chants, readings, and silence. They are followed by port and hot chocolate.

On **Ascension Day** in 3rd week, there are special services in the morning and evening: a towertop experience near daybreak at St Michael's (followed by free breakfast) and a beautiful sung Eucharist at night in the cathedral.

House Communion is an opportunity in 4th week for the whole college to gather for prayer and to enjoy a wonderful meal in hall. Guests are warmly welcome.
