Welcome from the Dean

Welcome to Christ Church Cathedral, at the heart of the City of Oxford.

Christ Church is a constituent college of the University of Oxford. As well as being a College, Christ Church is the Cathedral Church of the Diocese of Oxford, which covers the counties of Berkshire, Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire. First established in 1525, Christ Church is one of Oxford's largest colleges. Its name in Latin is *Ædes Christi*, meaning 'house of Christ', and the foundation is thus sometimes known as 'The House'. As a foundation, it is unique, comprising a College, Cathedral and Choir School – and of course a world-class Cathedral Choir, with a reputation for some of the world's finest music.

This booklet lists the music for all our services this month. You are welcome to join in the Hymns – and listen to the Psalms, Chants and Anthems – as you participate in worship with us. We hope and pray that your time here will be moving and uplifting – one of blessing and peace, and of spiritual nourishment and comfort.

St. Augustine of Hippo (354-430 AD) wrote that 'singing belongs to one who loves'.
