

Important Information for visiting Christ Church as a Group

Thank you for booking your group for a self-guided multimedia guide tour of Christ Church.

Check in:

Please arrive at the Groups check in area at our Visitor Centre in Christ Church Meadow shortly before the visit time confirmed by us. Upon arrival the group leader will be required to provide the booking reference number and a copy of this PDF to the member of staff on duty (paper or digital copy). The group leaders will be asked to sign that they have read and understood this document when checking in. Only the number of people booked and confirmed by us will be permitted entry.

Bringing children (under 18s) to visit Christ Church

In line with our safeguarding policy there must be a ratio of 1 adult to supervise every 10 children under 18 years old.

The supervising adult/s must be 21 years or above and it is their responsibility to remain with the children throughout the visit and oversee their welfare, behaviour and conduct on site. The children must not be left alone at any time whilst in the Visitor Centre, College or Cathedral.

There will be <u>no charge</u> for the supervising adult/s (as per the ratio) but they must be included in the overall number of visitors. <u>A multimedia guide will not be provided to supervising adults</u>. They will instead be issued with a map to help them navigate the site with the children and it will also include important information related to their responsibilities whilst at Christ Church. Supervising adults will also be issued with a flag to carry so that they can be easily identified by staff on site as the person responsible for the children they are supervising.

As the city's coach park is some distance from Christ Church we are not able to accept coach drivers as supervising adults.

Practical Information:

If you are going to be late please call the following number 01865 286573 and speak to the Duty Supervisor.

Christ Church does not have any left luggage facilities. Suitcases, luggage, and bags larger than 40cm x 30cm x 20cm (H x W x D) may not be brought on site. Please do not bring these items with you as unfortunately

you will not be permitted to enter with them. Random bag checks are in operation.

Skateboards, scooters, and any type of bicycle are not permitted on site and we do not have facilities to store them. Please do not bring these items with you.

Please note any abuse either physical or verbal will not be tolerated.

Please be aware of the advice issued by the Police about your safety in the rare event of an armed incident. CCTV images are being recorded for the purposes of crime prevention and public safety.
