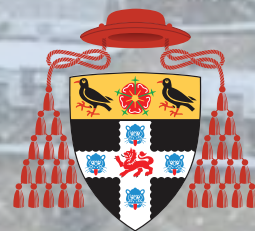

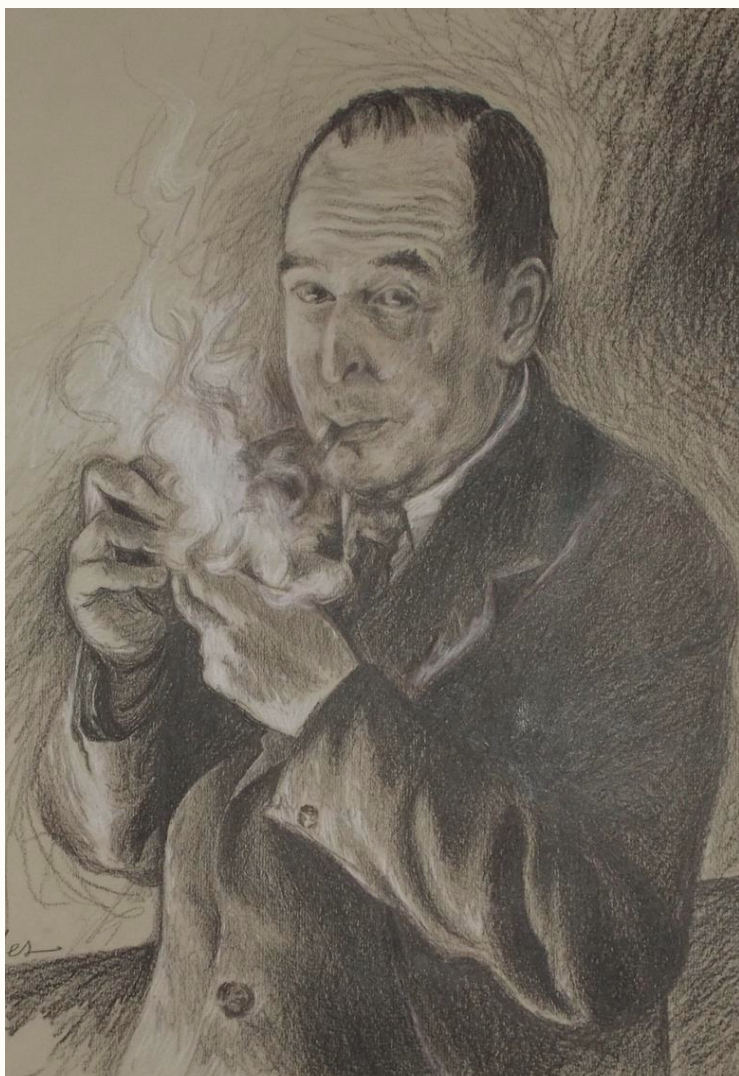
## Life Together #Oxford
