Dimensions	35.5 metres length: average height ca 0.7 m x width, between 0.5 and 0.8 m.
Layout	Layout corresponds to that of a typical Sephardi Torah scroll. Text is written in average, in three columns per parchment sheet. There are 50 lines of text per column.

Decoration	With tagin; wooden rollers have been decorated both on the outside and the inside
